Terms and Conditions of the Murau Tourism Association

When booking an individually selected accommodation, essentially the General Terms and Conditions for Hotels of the Austrian Hotel Association (AGBH) apply with these cancellation rules: Up to 30 Days prior no fee, 29 to 7 days 30 %, from 6 days 70 %. Late arrival/no show 90 % of the cancelled nights. Should the accommodation provider disclose its own terms and conditions on cancellations and payment in making the booking, these then apply.

I. General Terms and Conditions for the Hotel Industry

The Tourist Office Region Murau, herafter referred to as "Tourist Office", acts as facilitator when entering a business relationwith a guest requiring a reservation. Therefore a contract is formed between theguest and the accommodation establishment, hereafter referred to as the "Proprietor". The following general terms & Double Conditions apply to such a contract subject to the version applicable attime of booking. Possible demands out of this contract can only be asserteddirectly with the contracting party without any liabilty whatsoever to the Tourist Office. The Tourist Office acts under the expression with the guest, that the reservation, as well as the placement thereof, falls under the ruling of the "General Terms and Conditions for the Hotel Industry", herinafter referred to as "AGBH 2006".

Until latest 3 months before the agreed arrival day, both parties, i.e. the guest as well as the Proptietor,may cancel the reservation contract without any due cancellation fees on eitherside. The writting cancellation must reach the contracting partner within thisperiod of time Until latest 1 month beforethe agreed arrival date the guest may cancel the reservation contract subjectto a respective cancellation fee. The written cancellation must also reach the contracting partner within this period of time. A cancellation fee of 40% of the package price is payable. In case of a cancellationup to 1 week before arrival day, the applicable cancellation fee is 70%, withinthe last week 90% of the package price

II. Additional General Terms

- 1. The contracting partners agree on Austrian law in respect of the accommodationcontract as well as the booking process made on behalf of the guest.
- 2. Side agreements were not made
- 3. Amendments or additions to this contract have to be made in writing
- 4. Any disputes arising from this business action also about the nature of this businessaction are at the sole jurisdiction of the municipal court of the city of the Tourist Office.
- 5. Place of performance for all services ist the tourist destination represented by the Tourist Office.
- 6. The accommodation establishment confirmes explicitly that all bookings made onbehalf of a guest are subject to the "2006 General Terms and Conditions for the Hotel Industry"; inaddition the accommodation establishments confirms the receipt and knowledge of the entire content of the General Terms & Conditions and accepts same infull for every booking made on behalf of a guest.
- 7. The Tourist Office processes data for persons and establishments with attention the data protection act. The received data are exclusively ascertained, processed and used as far as is necessary for substantiatinons, arrangement oramendments of our own or facilitated busines relations. The Tourist Office is entitled to pass on data to its contracted partners, as far as isnecessary, to process reservations and requests. On the explicit agreement of theguest, the Tourist Office is further entitled to use and process thedata received for means of consultations, advertisement, marketing research aswell as offers meeting specific demands.
- 8. No liability is accepted for the contents and its accuracy of the accommodationestablishments as well as the picture material provided.
